

# Financing of the free schools 2022

## ● School fees

Average cost is approximately 15.282 DKK/2054€/2168USD per student per year.

## ● State subsidy

Free schools receive a subsidy from the government, determined in the annually finance Act. Free schools receive a sum based on the expenses in the public schools. In 2022 this amounted 76% of the expenses per student in the public school, approx. 7 billions DKK.

## ● After school programme

Some Danish municipalities offer a subsidy to private after school programmes. Most clubs are based on parent funding alone.

## ● Municipality


The public schools are run by the 98 Danish municipalities. When a child attends a free school and not the public school, the municipality pay a financial contribution to the state government. In 2022 this is 40.344 DKK per year per pupil. **When a pupil attends a free school, the municipality has a reduced expense of 33.494 DKK/4.4500 €/4743 USD per pupil per year.**

## ● Free school

All free schools receive a subsidy from the government, depending on number and age of the pupils and geography. In 2022 a free schools received (av.) 52.578 DKK/7.070 €/7.459 USD.

## ● Kindergarten & Daycare

Private kindergarten and daycare associated with a free school are financed by the municipality and parental payment.
